I. Standing Agenda Items/Updates

a. Public Health Director Updates

i. Local and Regional/State COVID Case and Hospitalization Statistics and Trends

Amy Wineland noted that across the state, cases are still in decline, with an increase in variants and a slight spike in hospitalizations.

Summit County has had an increase in cases over the last week, causing concern due to metrics that are in Level Orange.

ii. Local Testing Statistics and Program Update

Ms. Wineland noted that Summit County's testing is in increased demand.

iii. Vaccine Distribution Update

Ms. Wineland noted that 40% of Summit County residents age 16 and older have had at least one vaccine. Phase 1B.4 started last Friday, with 3 pods last week. This week, Summit County Public Health will distribute 500 doses of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine for restaurant workers and 870 Pfizer 1st doses. Several more weeks will be required to get through Phase 1B.4.

iv. Transmission Trends

Ms. Wineland noted that the Contact Tracing team has noticed increases in variant cases. There has been a trend of outbreaks in restaurants and retail space with social settings in and out of the workplace.

b. Communications Update and Discussion

Nicole Valentine noted that current messaging includes testimonials from volunteers and restaurant workers receiving the vaccine, door to door delivery of flyers regarding vaccination of restaurant workers, Thursday's upcoming Dial 3.0 Business Town Hall, and the upcoming Town Hall schedule.

c. Emergency Management Update




