Basic Requirements For Patrol Deputy Applicants:

- 21 years old
- US Citizen
- High School Diploma
- Valid Colorado Driver's License
- Ability to work various shifts, weekends and holidays
- Ability to perform basic job functions of a Patrol Deputy

Qualified candidates meeting the above requirements must also be one of the following:

- Currently Colorado P.O.S.T certified
- Laterals: Currently hold out-of-state certification and able to obtain a Colorado P.O.S.T Provisional certification prior to start date
- Academy Cadets: Must be Colorado P.O.S.T certifiable within 2-months of the Sheriff's Office testing date

Any applications received not meeting one of the above P.O.S.T requirements will be forwarded to the Detentions Division

Disqualification Guidelines For Patrol Deputy Applicants:

At the discretion of the Sheriff, the following criteria may cause the disqualification of an applicant from the Patrol Deputy selection process:

DRIVING HISTORY

- Any suspension, revocation or denial of a request for a driver's license within the last **five years**
- Any conviction for DUI/DWAI/DUID within the past **five years**
- More than one conviction for DUI/DWAI/DUID

EMPLOYMENT HISTORY AND DISCIPLINE (including military)

- Any intentional omission or falsification of any question contained in the Summit County Sheriff's Office employment application
- Any court martial resulting in dismissal from military service within the last **five years**

EXCESSIVE FORCE/VIOLENCE

- Except as authorized by law, any use of physical force against another person resulting in physical harm, requiring medical attention within the last **three years**
- While employed as a law enforcement officer, any suspension for excessive force within the last **three years**
- Any commission or conviction of any unlawful sexual contact
- Any commission or conviction of child abuse resulting in any injury
- Any conviction for domestic abuse that prohibits the carrying of a firearm

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- Any individual debt or debts totaling \$1,000.00 or more that is or was 90 days delinquent within the last **two years**
- Knowingly writing two or more non-sufficient funds checks totaling \$500.00 or more within the last **three years**
- Any delinquent child support payments within the last **five years**

INTEGRITY

- Any commission or conviction of a misdemeanor offense, not including traffic offenses, within the last **three years**
- Any commission or conviction of a felony offense
- Falsification of any official document
- Knowingly offering, soliciting or accepting a bribe

NARCOTICS BEHAVIOR

- Any use or possession of any form of marijuana within the last **two years**
- Any use of a narcotic, including but not limited to cocaine, LSD, mushrooms, steroids or amphetamines within the last **five years**
- Any distribution or manufacture of a controlled substance
